Eunice Reddick is a career member of the Senior Foreign Service. A former Chief of Mission, Ms. Reddick has extensive experience working on Africa issues, including working overseas to promote good governance and anti-corruption measures while building strong relationships with the host government. She is widely known for building strong teams.

Ms. Reddick currently is the Director of the Office for West African Affairs in the Bureau of African Affairs (2011-2013). She was Ambassador in Libreville, Gabon, accredited also to the Democratic Republic of Sao Tome and Principe (2007-2010). Her other senior positions include Director of the Office of East African Affairs in the Bureau of African Affairs (2005-2007), Director and Deputy Director of the Office of Philippines, Malaysia, Brunei, and Singapore Affairs in the Bureau of East Asian and Pacific Affairs (2000-2004), and Counselor for Political Affairs at the American Institute in Taiwan in Taipei (1998-2000). She has served as Deputy Director in both the Office of International Development in the Bureau of International Organization Affairs, and the Office of Burma, Cambodia, Laos, Thailand, and Vietnam Affairs in the Bureau of East Asian and Pacific Affairs. She also was a Senior Watch Officer in the Operations Center. She was a Staff Assistant and Refugee Affairs Officer in the Bureau of Population, Refugees, and Migration Affairs. Overseas, she has served as a Political Officer in China and a Consular Officer in Zimbabwe.

Ms. Reddick earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in history and literature from New York University and a Master of International Affairs degree from Columbia University. She speaks and reads French and Mandarin Chinese. She has received two Senior Foreign Service Performance Awards.
