College Discounts for Federal Employees/Family Members and Colleges Offering Online Programs

On June 24, 2016, the State Department notified its employees that the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) has entered into several agreements providing Federal employees' and their families with discounted rates for educational resources. Federal Employees and their families can enjoy reduced tuition rates at a number of academic institutions.

- **University of Maryland University College** (UMUC) – provides a 25 percent discount on out-of-state tuition rates on courses, certificates, and degree programs. UMUC offers 95 undergraduate and graduate degree or certificate programs, most of which are available online.
