

Have You Voted in the 2017 AFSA Election?

The AFSA Committee on Elections encourages members to participate in the 2017 AFSA election. As of May 8, 15% of the voting population have cast their ballots. Members who have not yet voted are reminded of the following:

- Online voting instructions were emailed to all voting members of AFSA for whom we had a valid email address on Monday, April 17, 2017. A reminder email was sent to those who had not yet voted on May 1. The subject line read, "AFSA Ballot and Login Info." The email contained unique voting pass code information. Do not forward the email.

- If you did not receive the original email or reminder, that
 may mean we do not have a valid email address on file for
 you. Please contact the Committee on Elections at
 election@afsa.org.
- Members should add <u>noreply@directvote.net</u> to their email address books to ensure delivery. Please <u>click here for</u> <u>instructions</u> on how to add an email address to your directory.
- Members who have not yet voted and prefer to vote by printed ballot, may request one by emailing election@afsa.org or calling 1 (952) 974-2339.

- Printed ballots were mailed to those for whom we did not have a valid email address on Monday, April 17, 2017.
 Members may return the printed ballot or visit the <u>online</u> <u>voting site</u> to cast an online ballot after receiving the printed ballot which contains unique voting pass code information.
- If you haven't received either your printed ballot or online voting instructions, please contact <u>election@afsa.org</u>. You will need to provide your name, address, constituency and email address.
- Voters are reminded that they may visit the online AFSA Community to pose questions of the candidates or post comments on the AFSA election discussion thread. Members will need to log in to the members-only area of the AFSA website using their primary email address and password. If you have not logged in before, click on the "forgot password" link and an automatic "update password" link will be emailed to you.

The AFSA Committee on Elections would like to remind all members that AFSA as an organization neither endorses nor supports any specific candidate or slate.

Ballots will be counted on June 8, 2017. The results will be announced shortly thereafter. The new AFSA Governing Board will take office on July 15, 2017.
