Eric Geelan joined the Foreign Service in 2002, and moved from Spain to Washington with his wife and two boys. His initial tour was a Consular/Political rotation in Caracas, Venezuela from 2003 to 2005. After a year at FSI in language training learning Arabic, Mr. Geelan was posted to Jerusalem, where he served as an Assistant Cultural Affairs Officer from 2006-2008, working on exchange programs for West Bank and Gaza.

Geelan's next tour was in Panama as Deputy in the Political Section from 2008 to 2011, focusing on political

security issues. He next moved to London, from 2011 to 2014, where he ran the Political-Military team. He is currently serving as the Deputy Director of the International Security Operations office in the Bureau of Political-Military Affairs.
