



THEODORE S. WILKINSON

Theodore S. Wilkinson joined the Foreign Service in 1961. During his 35-year Foreign Service career, he served in a number of U.S. embassies in Europe and Latin America, at NATO, and at the United Nations. He served twice in Mexico City, the second time as minister counselor for political affairs from 1991 to 1994, and from 1996-1998 he was the U.S. representative to the Guarantor's Commission in Brasilia supporting peace negotiations between Peru and Ecuador.

Mr. Wilkinson served as the President of the American Foreign Service Association (AFSA) from 1989 to 1991, and represented retired Foreign Service employees on the AFSA Governing Board from 2003 to 2005. From 2005 to 2011, Mr. Wilkinson chaired the *Foreign Service Journal* Editorial Board.
