Vietnam has many beautiful beach resort towns that dot its long coastline that have been developed to attract thousands of (still mostly) foreign tourists. But Cua Lo Beach near the port city of Vinh still drew local beachgoers. All along the beach road were grills selling freshly cooked seafood and cheap beer. The traditional round fishing boats, sealed with black tar and notoriously hard to steer, have mostly been converted for joyrides on the water.
